Join us for this **free** webinar to learn about the process of applying for the Pennsylvania Unified Certification Program (PAUCP) from application expert Sue Broadus, DBE/DB Program Manager at the Port Authority of Allegheny County. PAUCP certification is free and is available to all socially and economically disadvantaged businesses who qualify for the program. The PAUCP certification program is designed to ensure there is equal access to DBE firms in contracts funded by the United States Department of Transportation. This certification is also widely accepted by state and local government agencies to confirm disadvantaged status. Ms. Broadus will provide an overview of the program, review the application and the personal net worth statement and discuss additional documents needed for certification.

****Note:** The definition of a DBE business is: Women, Black Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, Asian – Pacific Americans, Subcontinent Asian Americans and other minorities found to be disadvantaged by the SBA. ******
